Dear Parents,

As part of our curriculum in Health, Consumer Homemaking and Psychology students are provided a well-planned sequence of instruction in *Family and Social Health* taught by district personnel. Parents will be notified if outside consultants or guest speakers will be used to present topics in the curriculum. The curriculum is age appropriate and includes discussion of issues that are important to healthy adolescent development, including HIV/AIDS prevention.

The California Education Code requires schools to notify parents about their instruction in comprehensive sexual health education and HIV/AIDS prevention education. Parents may request a copy of Education Code Sections 51390-51398 which pertain to California Comprehensive Sexual Health and HIV/AIDS Prevention Education Act.

The Family and Social Health unit is designed to provide students with medically accurate and factual information that promotes thoughtful and responsible behavior. Topics in the unit include decision-making skills: friendship/relationships; reproductive anatomy and physiology; sexually transmitted diseases; contraception, with an emphasis on abstinence; teen pregnancy; and sexual assault; and parenting. Parents/guardians may request in writing that their child not receive comprehensive sexual health or HIV/AIDS prevention education.

Parents/guardians may review the written and audiovisual instructional materials that are used in the comprehensive sexual education and HIV/AIDS prevention lessons. The materials are available for review on Back to School Night, September 2, 2015 at 6:00 pm in room 217.
